1. <u>APPROVAL OF MINUTES</u>

The minutes of February 6, 2019, were approved.

2. CAMPUS SOLUTIONS GO-LIVE TIMELINE

Vice Chancellor Neault passed out an updated Timeline for the implementation of various features of the Campus Solutions system. She reviewed the upcoming milestones, as the different functions come online. These changes will be communicated to relevant groups in advance of each milestone. An example of the targeted timeline for students was passed out, and changes recommended. Mesa College Academic Senate President Kim Perigo asked whether there was a need for beta testers. Vice Chancellor Neault indicated that there would be a need in mid-March. Continuing Education Academic Senate President Richard Weinroth volunteered to serve. Vice Chancellor Neault summarized the help desk/support services that will be available during and immediately after the transition.

3. BROWN ACT UPDATE

Miramar College Academic Senate President Marie McMahon raised questions at the District Governance Council (DGC) meeting about changes in the Brown Act as a result of the passage of AB 2257. Director of Legal Services Ljubisa Kostic provided a summary of the changes. Essentially, this legislation requires more prominent electronic positing and links to governing board agendas on the landing pages of organizations' websites. These requirements only pertain to governing boards, not to "political subdivisions" in the organizations. Thus, there is no impact on Academic Senates or Associated Students organizations.

4. PARTICIPATORY GOVERNANCE WORKSHOP

Vice Chancellor Neault disseminated and reviewed a proposed presentation outline for the forthcoming participatory governance workshop that will be helpful during the March 14, 2019, Board meeting.
