3. STATE BUDGET UPDATE

Executive Vice Chancellor Dowd reviewed selected slides from the 2019-20 SDCCD Adopted Budget which was presented at the September 12 Board of Trustees' meeting.

4. STUDENT SERVICES POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

Vice Chancellor Neault explained category 2 revisions to AP 3100.2. The administrative procedure now includes an addendum for Title IX procedures in response to legal and/or regulatory requirements. Dr. Neault indicated that the procedure was based on legal standards and modeled after the UC system.

5. ADJUNCT HIRING PROCESS UPDATE

Vice Chancellor Surbrook answered several questions raised at the July 17 DGC meeting by City College Academic Senate President Jan Jarrell. He reported that diversity questions will be attached to all positions, including adjunct. He added that the adjunct pools are screened for minimum qualifications and that they are purged annually with an email sent to applicants to reapply if they are still interested in employment.

Shelly Hess brought back policies and procedures for a final review. AP 5025 will come back to a future DGC meeting for further review.
