APPLY FOR VA EDUCATIONAL BENEFITS

Apply for VA educational benefits and obtain your Certificate of Eligibility (COE). The Department of Veterans of Affairs will mail your COE; processing time is approximately 30–45 days.

Submit a copy of your COE to the college Veterans Affairs Office after registering for classes.

Students only need to submit one college application to the San Diego Community College District in order to attend classes at Miramar, Mesa and City college.

CH 31: Veterans Readiness & Employment (VR&E)



CH31 VR&E students must have authorization on file with the primary campus VA Office prior to submitting documentation for VA enrollment certification. CH 35: Dependents Educational Assistance (DEA)

CH 35 DEA recipients are paid a monthly stipend based on approved units. Tuition and fees <u>must</u> be paid before submitting documents for VA enrollment certification. Sponsor's SSN or VA file number is <u>required</u> on Semester Worksheet to process certification.

CH 33: Post 9/11 GI Bill ©



CH 33 recipients receive a housing allowance that is prorated by the servicemember's length of service percentage. To be eligible for housing allowance rates, the student's rate of pursuit must be greater than 50% (greater than and not equal to 1/2 time status).

If students are not enrolled in the same start and end dates, benefits will be prorated by the VA.
